A few last minute updates:

1. **Weather** - The forecast looks ideal at present with cool conditions, little to no rain & a decent tailwind! There has been a fair amount of rain recently & there could be a couple of patches along the trail that are wet. A spare pair of shoes & socks would be a wise investment.
2. **Breakfast / Brunch** - Thanks to those who have put their hands up to come. There are still places left so if you decide that it sounds appealing on the day, there should be no problem getting a meal & a seat.
3. **Course Change** – that hopefully has caught your attention! Since last year, traffic lights have been installed at the Bellarine Hwy crossing which may prove good or bad depending upon their delay. Given the nature of the event, I must insist that you cross only when it is legal to do so. There will be 2 marshals on the crossing trying to perfect their timing of pressing the buttons but it is inevitable that there will be a short delay at times. Feel free to jog in circles but please obey the marshal's instructions.
4. **Transport** – is available ONLY BEFORE the event! I hope most people are now aware of this. The bus should be there by 7.30am. Please have \$5 ready for collection as you get on the bus as Wendy, who is helping out at that end, won't be travelling on the bus & we need to try to be away by 7.40am. She will collect the money & check off your name so you don't need to check in at the Geelong end. If you are catching the bus, please aim to be there by 7.30am at the latest.
5. **Registration** – if you are not catching the bus, you MUST register your attendance at the start so that we know who is out on the course. We will also be writing numbers on hands for easy reference at the end of times & who has finished.
6. **Transport of bags** – a reminder that there will be a car or cars designated to take bags, etc from Geelong to Queenscliff once the run has started. I recommend those on the bus bring a bag & some warm clothes to get to the start & deposit these in the cars.
